Our writing will be inspired by a range of exciting texts and stories. Children will develop their storytelling skills, descriptive language, sentence structure, and confidence as writers while continuing to foster a love of reading.

Geography – Bright Lights, Big City

We will be learning about the physical and human characteristics of the United Kingdom, with a special focus on its capital city, London. Children will explore famous landmarks, compare different locations, and develop their geographical understanding of the UK.

Art – Street View

We will be exploring artwork that depicts streets and buildings, focusing on the vibrant work of the American pop artist James Rizzi. Children will develop their artistic skills by creating their own colourful 3-D mural inspired by his unique style.

Design & Technology – Taxi!

Our focus is Taxi! Children will learn about wheels, axles, and chassis, investigating how these parts work together to make vehicles move. They will apply their knowledge to design and create their own moving vehicle.

Religious Education

In RE, we will be exploring the question: Who is God to Sikhs? as part of our learning about Sikhi and sacred people. We will also investigate why Jesus was welcomed like a king or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday as part of our Christianity unit.

We will continue to develop our physical skills through a range of activities that build coordination, balance, agility, teamwork, and confidence.

Computing

In computing, we will continue to learn how to use technology safely and responsibly while developing our digital skills through a variety of engaging activities.

Music
